Established in 1997, Latvia Medical School offers programs in medicine, nursing, and pharmacy. All courses align with European Union standards. Instruction is

provided in both Latvian and English. Each program has achieved top ratings in the national study program evaluation conducted by the Council of Higher Education, confirming their strong sustainability. Practical training is a key component of the curriculum. Additionally, EU citizens have the opportunity to take part in an educational exchange program, allowing them to study for up to three months at a university in another EU member state. University of Latvia is the largest and most influential higher education institution in Latvia, playing a crucial role in the country's education system and economy.

In 2024, the University of Latvia held its graduation ceremonies from June 8 to July 2, celebrating the achievements of over 4,000 students across 13 faculties. The ceremonies were primarily conducted in the Aula Magna, the university's Great Hall, located at Raiņa bulvāris 19 in Riga. The graduation events commenced with the Nutrition Science master's program on June 8 and concluded with the Nursing Professional Bachelor Study Programme on July 2. Notably, the Faculty of Business, Management and Economics held its ceremony on June 21, while the Faculty of Social Sciences celebrated on June 27. Graduates from faculties such as Economics and Management, Law, Social Sciences, and Humanities were among the largest groups to receive their diplomas. Following tradition, graduates often marked the occasion by taking photographs at the university's main entrance. The schedule for these ceremonies was published in the spring, allowing students and their families to prepare for this significant milestone. The event was also marked by the attendance of the **Director of ICD**, highlighting the university's commitment to supporting graduates in their professional growth.

Eligibility Criteria: Latvia University

1. Applicants must be at least 17 years old at the time of admission to the MBBS program in Latvia.
2. Candidates should have completed their Higher Secondary education or an equivalent 12th-grade examination before admission.
3. Physics, Chemistry, and Biology must have been the main subjects studied during the Higher Secondary examination.

4. A minimum of 50% marks is required in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology individually, along with an overall aggregate of at least 50%.
5. For SC/ST/OBC candidates, the minimum required percentage is relaxed to 40%.

Documents Required: Latvia University

1. You must provide your Class 10th and Class 12th mark sheets and certificates when applying for an MBBS in Latvia.
2. Additionally, you need to submit your migration certificate, admit card, and self-attested copies of all relevant documents for admission.
3. A valid passport and student visa are required for studying MBBS in Latvia.
4. The passport should be valid for at least five years from the date of issue and must be stamped by the Ministry of External Affairs.
5. Information about your parents' financial status and proof of payment for the course fees must be submitted.
6. Any other documents requested by the Latvian Ministry of External Affairs or the university must also be provided.
7. A police-issued certificate confirming no criminal record is also necessary.

Admission Procedure: Latvia University

- Select one of Latvia's top-ranked universities to pursue your MBBS degree.
- Complete and submit the detailed online application form on the university's official website.
- Pay the required fees after receiving the approval letter from the university.
- Apply for a student visa to study and reside in Latvia.

- Book your flight tickets once your visa is granted by the Latvian authorities.
- Ensure you have all the necessary documents needed for your studies in Latvia
- After completing all these formalities, you're all set to travel to Latvia and begin your MBBS journey in this wonderful country.
